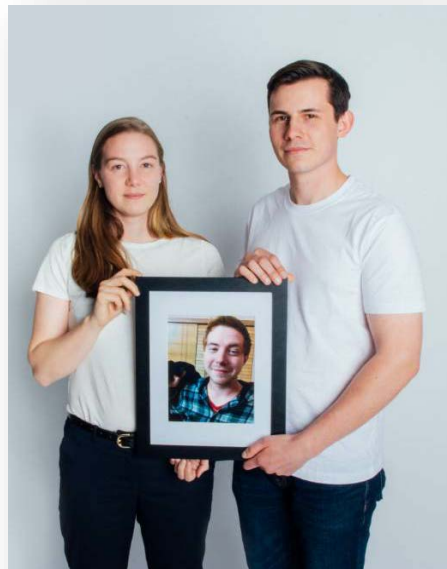

Support national collaborations

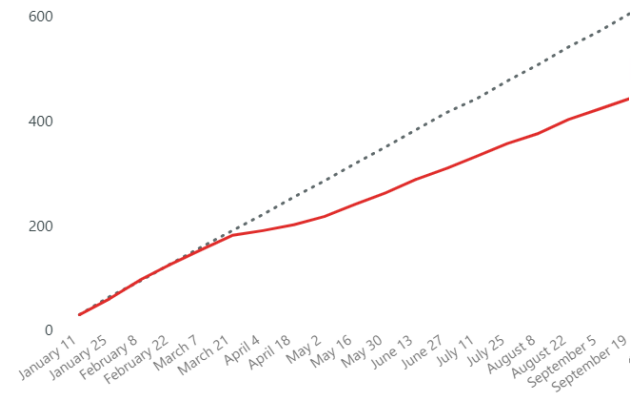
Optimize program infrastructure

2020 Canadian trends in organ donation

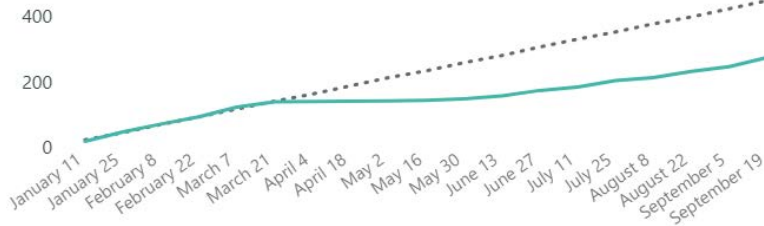
Deceased donors

● Benchmark ● 2020 Cumulative Total

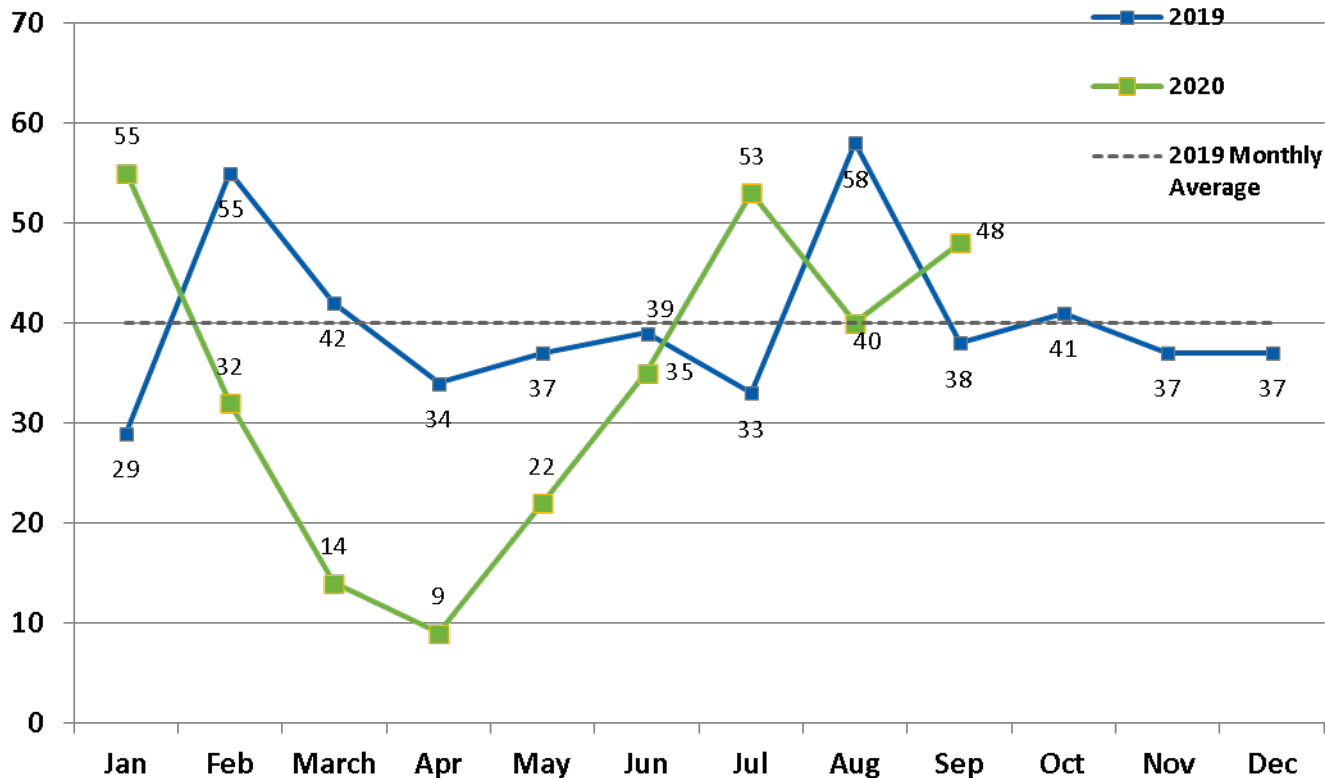


Living donors

● Benchmark ● 2020 Cumulative Total

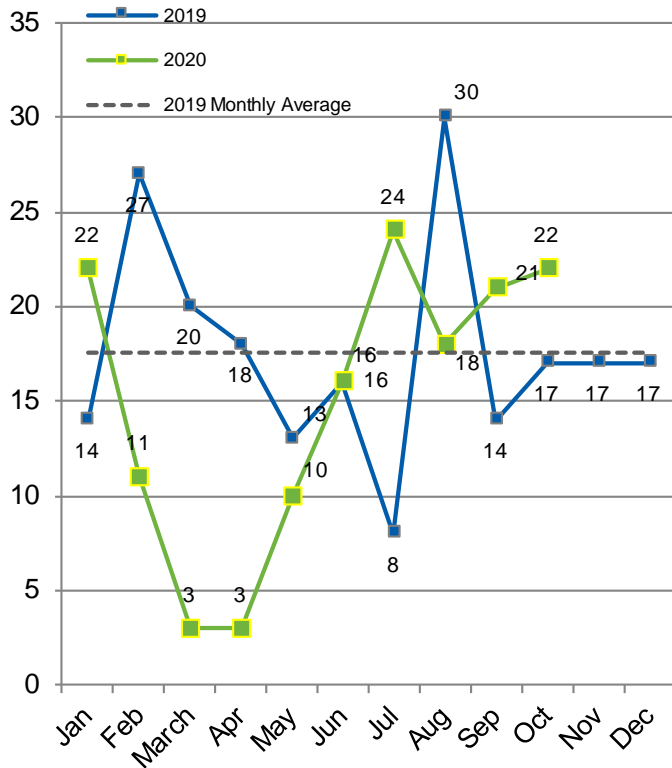


2020 living and deceased donor transplants

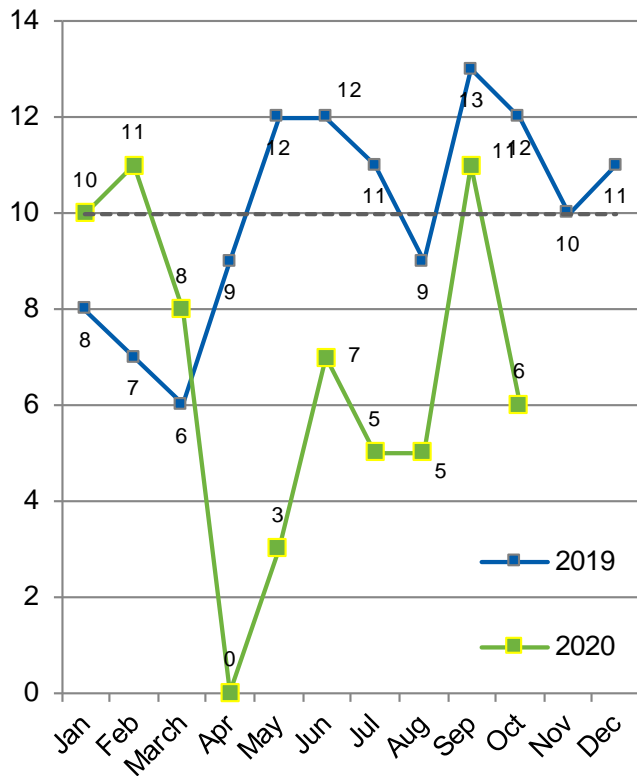


2019 and 2020 YTD Kidney Transplants
