To provide GPs and PCPs with tools and resources that will enable them to identify signs of CKD earlier and potentially enable them to prevent CKD where possible or delay progression of disease. To deliver important and relevant CKD education to GPs and PCPs that will enrich their practice. To ensure that primary care providers and GPs in rural communities have more educational support that will allow them to be up to date with key treatments and prevention strategies for Chronic kidney disease. After attending a CKD E-Learning sessions, participants will be able to provide chronic disease management in a planned, proactive manner. To expand the reach of this education series.
