	Membership will be reviewed annually. The Chair position will be reviewed by the group every 2 years.
5. Reporting Relationships	The HD Technical Group is a standing working group of the Hemodialysis Committee and reports to the Hemodialysis Committee.
6. Meetings	<ul> <li>Bi-monthly teleconference/ video/ WebEx meetings to review current status, updates, etc. during the months that fall in-between the Hemodialysis Committee meetings.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Meetings may also be held at the call of the Chair on an ad hoc basis, and will be by teleconference or face-to- face. Meetings will be scheduled at a location and date that is convenient for most members.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Health Authority Renal Program representatives may join a meeting as a guest upon request.</li> </ul>
7. BCPRA Support	<ul> <li>BCPRA project management support will ensure the group's projects are implemented within scope, timeline, and budget.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>BCPRA administrative support will ensure minutes and communications are distributed to the group members and the Hemodialysis Committee.</li> </ul>
