Completing an Acuity Assessment

When to complete:

- Complete on all HD patients (chronic and acute) twice a year (in April & October).
- How to complete:
 - 1. Navigate to Acuity Assessment screen as per previous slide.
 - 2. Click Add to add a new acuity record. This will open a form with 7 tabs.
 - 3. In the General tab, select the Scale Used and enter the Assessment Date.

- Click on each of the other tabs. Each tab represents one area of the acuity scale (hemodynamics to psychosocial/ emotional factors).
- Within each tab, there are multiple criteria.
 For each criteria, select the descriptor which is appropriate for the patient.

- 2. A warning message will appear if you click on Save or Save and Exit when there are incomplete tabs.
- 3. Upon completing the assessment and clicking on **Save and Exit** button a successful message will appear.

Editing an Acuity Assessment

To view/edit details:

- Select the assessment to be edited from the Acuity Assessment summary page. Can use the Notes button on the top right to enter comments if desired. The button will be disabled if there are no notes added to the record.
- To edit an assessment, click on the pencil icon. This will open the Edit Assessment screen. After making edits, click on Save and Exit.



Note: It is not possible to add multiple assessments with the same date for a patient.

Deleting an Acuity Assessment

To delete an acuity assessment:

- Select the assessment to be deleted from the Acuity Assessment summary page.
- 2. To delete an assessment, click on **Delete**. A message will appear asking you to remove the assessment results then try again.
- 3. Click on OK.
- 4. Click on the pencil icon to edit the assessment. Go to each tab and manually deselect each category.
- 5. Click on Save and Exit to exit the edit screen.
- 6. Click on **Delete** to delete the assessment. A confirmation message will appear. Enter a **Deletion Reason** and click on **Delete**.



You are only able to delete an assessment you created.

Acuity Level Report

The report includes 2 sections:

1. Patients Assessed:

- Lists all patients in the selected dialysis unit with an open HD status (HD Conventional, HD+PD, HD Short Daily, HD Slow Nocturnal)
- Shows the most recent assessment based on the 'Assessment as of' date parameter.
- Incomplete or missing assessments will appear with blank fields.

2. Patient Count:

- Lists the number and percentage of patients in each acuity level category.
- Includes patients with competed assessments only (does not include patients with incomplete or missing assessments).
