Accuracy in Medication records

Take care with medication entry

For example, avoid overlap

Date	Drug	Dosage
19-AUG-19	FERROUS FUMARATE	PO Take 300 mg once daily.
19-AUG-19	FERROUS FUMARATE	PO Take 300 mg at bedtime.

Use appropriate Dose Type and End Dates to tell the whole story

Date	Drug	Dosage
26-SEP-19	IRON SUCROSE	IV Take 200 mg as directed by physician. weekly x 3 doses
26-NOV-19	IRON SUCROSE	IV Take 200 mg as directed by physician. monthly thereafter the 3 weekly doses are done

Anemia Related Reports

General Data Entry QA Report

To check your patients:

- ▶ have ESA medications verified every six months
- ▶ proper directions exist in the ESA prescription
- ▶ On Hold exists when patient not currently on ESA

Where to find: PROMIS 4 > Reports > Centre Reports > General Data Entry QA

EPO/Iron Reports

To help with management of anemia

To see:

- ▶ which of your patients have multiple ESA/Iron prescriptions open
- ▶ whose prescriptions have changed
- ▶ patients who have no Primary Nephrologist
- ▶ your patients' iron dosing and iron lab test results

Where to find: Classic > Reports > EPO/Iron Reports
