

Kidney Transplant Education Candidacy Criteria



Do Not Proceed

Do not proceed with transplant education if any of the following apply:

- Age > 85
- Active non-compliance to therapy
- Active drug or alcohol addiction
- Active malignancy (excluding non-melanoma skin cancer)
- Active infection (e.g. TB)
- Uncontrolled psychiatric disorder
- Severe cognitive impairment
- Severe ischemic heart disease
- Severe peripheral vascular disease
- Oxygen dependent respiratory conditions
- Uncontrolled cirrhosis



Consult Nephrologist

Consult with nephrologist, if unable to clearly identify contraindications under “Do not proceed”.

Consult with nephrologist about providing transplant education if any of the following apply:

- Age 70 to 85
- eGFR not clearly declining
- Fluctuating compliance
- Extensive comorbidities



If no red or yellow criteria apply, proceed with transplant education.
