



Renal (Kidney) Social Workers have education and skills to assist you and those close to you in dealing with the emotional and practical issues that may arise due to your kidney disease.

We can offer information about resources such as:

- Financial supports (Income Assistance, Disability Pensions)
- Tax tips and tax credits
- Transportation
- Medication coverage or supplies
- Home care assistance
- Subsidized housing or seniors housing
- Caregiver support

We provide education and advocacy for:

- Living well with kidney disease
- Options for treatment of kidney disease
- Patient's rights and responsibilities
- Guidance about future planning tools (Representation Agreements, Power of Attorney, Advance Care Plans)
