To whom it may concern:

______ is currently a patient in my care and receiving Peritoneal Dialysis treatment, a life sustaining therapy for kidney disease. Therapy consists of peritoneal dialysis treatments daily using a peritoneal dialysis cycler machine. This patient is travelling and will therefore be carrying one or more of the following items:

- Baxter or Fresenius peritoneal dialysis cycler with travel case
- Stickman portable peritoneal dialysis solution warmer
- Cassettes, drain lines and drain bags.
- Boxes of dialysis solution.
- Heparin, needles and syringes.
- Cleansing solutions, dressings, clamps and minicaps
- Medications (injectables and oral)

These supplies should be treated like prescription medications.

It should be noted that one or more of these supplies and/or medicines are affected by extreme temperatures and should be included in carry-on luggage. Please allow this patient to pass through security to board his/her flight with these medications and supplies.
