

# Angiotensin II Receptor Blockers

(candesartan, irbesartan, losartan, telmisartan, valsartan)

#### What it does:

Controls hypertension (high blood pressure) or heart failure.

### How it works:

Relaxes blood vessels, which lowers blood pressure.

#### How to take it:

It can be taken with or without meals. Take this medication as prescribed even if you feel well.

## What to do if you miss a dose:

If you miss a dose, take the missed medication as soon as you remember. If you do not remember the missed dose until it is time for the next dose (i.e. within 6 hours of your next dose if medication taken as a single daily dose or within 3 hours if medication taken more frequently than once daily), omit the missed dose and resume your regular dosing scheduling. DO NOT DOUBLE YOUR DOSE OR TRY TO "CATCH UP" BY TAKING EXTRA DOSES.

#### Possible side effects:

Contact your physician if you experience any of the following:

- Dizziness, light-headedness, faint upon rising up
- Skin rash and/or itch, fever, joint pain, sunlight sensitivity
- Swelling of face, mouth, hands, feet, trouble swallowing/breathing

Report on your next doctor's visit any of the following:

Fatigue, nosebleeds, ringing in the ears, constipation

Note: Dizziness or light-headedness may occur after the first dose or dose increase.
