

Provincial Renal Emergency Management Plan

Questions & Answers - Staff and Physicians

1. Is there a provincial renal emergency management plan?

Yes. The BC Provincial Renal Agency has a Provincial Emergency Management and Business Continuity Plan. This provincial plan will be initiated when one or more regional Renal Programs become overwhelmed by a disaster or emergency event.

2. Do you know where the BC Provincial Renal Agency has a Provincial Emergency Management and Business Continuity Plan is kept?

3. How is it initiated?

The Provincial Emergency Management and Business Continuity Plan is formally initiated through the PHSA Emergency Manager on-call. The plan contains a fan out list that the PHSA Emergency Manager on-call can use.

During an event there will be on-going communication between the BC Provincial Renal Agency and the impacted Renal Programs. If there is a need to initiate the provincial plan the BCPRA will be ready.

4. Do you know how the provincial renal disaster plan links to other levels of disaster response?
