|       | Kidney damage with mild renal dysfunction | 60-89                     |
|       | Moderate renal dysfunction                | 30-59                     |
| 4     | Severe renal dysfunction                  | 15-29                     |
| 5     | End-stage renal disease                   | <15                       |
