Category	Description
Purpose	To enhance and foster excellence in the delivery of Peritoneal Dialysis in BC through provincial standardized approaches to practice, educational resources, and supportive networking.
Responsibilities	Promote engagement, consultation, and collaboration among members to support professional nephrology nursing practice activities Actively participate in the development of practice that is patient centered, outcome focused, evidence informed and cost effective Incorporate collective critical reflection of practice to inform development of standardized practice procedures and/or processes in peritoneal dialysis. Develop, revise, and implement standardized provincial educational resources, processes and procedures that address identified issues/barriers to peritoneal dialysis. Review, monitor, assess, and recommend best practices in peritoneal dialysis (home or facility based) as they emerge locally, provincially, nationally, and internationally. Participate in discussions about educational and clinical practice needs of PD programs Participate in knowledge translation and exchange of clinical ideas to support best practice in PD
Accountabilities	Identification, development, and implementation of standardized approach(s) to PD practice in BC in alignment with best practice provincially, nationally, and internationally. Contribute to the mentorship and development of educational supports for new PD nurses working in PD programs Share PD practices and initiatives at the local PD program level for the benefit of learning and expertise development of the group Provide communication and feedback to respective health authority PD programs regarding initiatives, projects, and progress to date. Ensure existing standardized process is followed to bring contractual issues related to service/products forward for resolution to BC Renal

Reporting Relationships	Reports to and is accountable to the BC Renal Peritoneal Dialysis Committee. Reporting occurs at PD committee meetings.
Meetings	Minimum zoom/teleconference q 2 monthly. Email communications in between meetings Once a year face to face meeting scheduled with PD committee face to face meeting.
