Preparation: Gentamicin 2 mg/mL Lock Solution	
Materials: 1 gentamicin 40 mg/mL vial 3 x 10 mL sodium chloride 0.9% 1 x 30 mL sterile empty vial 9 x 10 mL sterile empty vials 1 x 3 mL syringe 1 x 35 mL syringe	Directions for Manufacturing: 1. Withdraw 1.5 mL of 40 mg/mL vial and transfer to an empty vial. 2. Add 28.5 mL sodium chloride 0.9% to 1.5 mL in the vial. Resulting concentration is 2 mg/mL . 3. Transfer 3 mL of gentamicin 2 mg/mL into each of the 9 empty vials. 4. Label vials with 30 day expiry
Label Sample: 3 mL gentamicin 2 mg/mL Lock Solution	Auxiliary Labels: Keep Refrigerated
