The Edmonton Symptom Assessment System (ESAS) provides a clinical profile of symptom severity over time and provides context for understanding a patient's symptoms. Patients score the severity of 12 symptoms. They can score each symptom from none 0 to worst possible 10. A score of 7 or more is considered severe.
